TRUSTEE CANDIDATE INTERVIEWS AND APPOINTMENT TO FILL TRUSTEE VACANCY

Trustee candidates drew lots to determine the order in which they would make presentations, and also drew lots to determine the rotating order in which they would respond to questions. In turn, Christopher Chiang, Amy Pearl, Elinora Mantovani, Pearl Cheng, Marsha Adler, Anabel Pelham, Tom Klein and Faith Brigel made presentations limited to five minutes that addressed their understanding of the role and mission of community colleges, their understanding of the Board's fiduciary responsibility and how they would carry it out, their personal goals and vision for the Foothill-De Anza Community College District, and why they believed they would be an outstanding trustee. Each of the candidates then took turns responding to the following questions read by President Casas Frier, with responses limited to two minutes:

- 1. As a trustee, who do you represent? How would you ensure that your decisions reflect the values and priorities of this constituency or these constituencies?
- 2. What criteria do you use to help formulate a recommendation in an environment of competing educational needs and limited financial resources?
- 3. Tell us about your experience with collective bargaining in the public sector and your philosophy of a trustee's role and responsibility in negotiations.
- 4. The Education Code and Foothill-De Anza board policies recognize the role of faculty, staff, administrators, students and employee groups (unions and meet-and-confer groups) as active participants in decision-making processes at the colleges. Describe your experience with participatory governance processes and how you would, as a trustee, ensure that input and feedback from college and district constituency groups is part of the district processes in decision-making.
- 5. Do you plan to run for election in one year?

Amy Pearl withdrew her candidacy during her response to Question #1. President Casas Frier and Trustee Bechtel thanked each of the candidates for applying. Trustee Plotkin spoke about the trustee appointment process several years ago in which he and Trustee Bechtel were not selected but eventually came to be seated on the Board, and urged the candidates to remain involved with Foothill-De Anza. Trustee Swenson said he was extraordinarily impressed with the applicants. Student Trustee Dukunde noted the opportunity to become a student trustee if enrolled as a student. Each trustee then voted as follows:

Student Trustee Ahrens gave an advisory vote for Pearl Cheng
Student Trustee Dukunde gave an advisory vote for Pearl Cheng
Trustee Plotkin voted for Pearl Cheng
Trustee Bechtel voted for Pearl Cheng, citing the additional consideration of representation from the communities of Cupertino and Sunnyvale and her connection to the Asian American community
President Casas Frier voted for Pearl Cheng
