

Police Departments

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The Board has established a police department under the supervision of the Director for District Safety and Security, who shall report directly to the Vice Chancellor for Business Services. The department shall have jurisdiction to enforce the law on or near the campuses and other grounds or properties owned, operated, controlled, or administered by the District.

District police officers shall be employed as members of the classified service but shall, when duly sworn, be peace officers as defined by law. Prior to employment, they shall satisfy the training requirements set out in Penal Code Sections 830, et seq.

The Chancellor shall establish minimum qualifications of employment for the Director for District Safety and Security including, but not limited to, prior employment as a peace officer or completion of a peace officer training course approved by the Commission on Peace Officers' Standards and Training.

The Vice Chancellor for Business Services, shall ensure that every member of the police department employed by the District satisfies the requirements of state law regarding qualifications for continued employment.

Every member of the police department shall be issued a suitable identification card and badge bearing the words "Foothill-De Anza Community College District Police."

The Vice Chancellor for Business Services, in cooperation with the Director for District Safety and Security, shall issue such other regulations as may be necessary for the effective administration of the police department.
