International Students Attending Under Exchange Agreements AP 5041

Nothing in Board Policy 5040 is intended to prohibit the admission of international students who are selected to attend Foothill or De Anza under an exchange agreement between the District and a foreign college, university or government. Furthermore, the administration may exempt any such student from all or a part of the tuition fees normally required of non-residents if:

- A. The exchange agreement under which the student will attend Foothill or De Anza specifies that both institutions will provide tuition- free enrollment at reduced tuition rates;
- B. The foreign student demonstrates financial need for the exemption as determined and certified by his or her home institution; and
- C. The foreign student enrolls in no more than 12 units per quarter and attends Foothill or De Anza under the exemption for no more than three quarters.

Any foreign student who is exempted from paying non-resident tuition (in whole or in part) will nevertheless be charged all of the ordinary enrollment fees generally imposed upon students.
