

Suspension/Termination of Support Services for Students with Disabilities

AP 5076

Under 5 California Code of Regulations Section 56010, students receiving support services or instruction shall: (1) comply with the student code of conduct adopted by the college and all other statutes and regulations related to student conduct; (2) be responsible in their use of Disabled Students Programs and Services (DSP&S) and adhere to written service provision policies adopted by DSP&S; and (3) make measurable progress toward the goals established in the Student Educational Contract or, when the student is enrolled in a regular college course, meet academic standards established by the college pursuant to Subchapter 8 (commencing with Section 55750) Chapter of Title 5. Failure to comply with (2) or (3) above may result in suspension or termination of services. Prior to suspension or termination of services the college shall provide a written notice of its intended action and an explanation of the reasons for doing so and the proposed date of suspension/termination, and shall afford the student the opportunity to appeal the decision. Each student shall be given a copy of the DSP&S policy upon applying for services.
