Consequently, although the primary responsibility for meeting college cost is considered to rest with the student and his/her family, Foothill and De Anza College supports a Financial Aid Office to provide assistance to students with documented financial need.

Foothill and De Anza College are committed to assisting students to pursue their educational objectives, regardless of their ability to pay. In compliance with federal, state, and local guidelines, Foothill and De Anza College will award financial aid to all eligible students who have completed the Financial Aid Office application procedure. No student shall be denied the opportunity to apply for financial assistance, although Foothill or De Anza College cannot guarantee all students who apply will receive an award of financial aid.
