- 1. Converted users.
 - All of De Anza Classified Staff, Managers and Administrators per Vartan.
- 2. On user was missed in the Central Services conversion.
 - Converting missed user priority for June 19, 2012.
- 3. Foothill A & R office and Management concerns over June 29, 2012 conversion.
 - Finals week, July 2nd start of Summer quarter and Faculty Mandate and Spring grade roll are all happening that weekend.
 - Concerned about not having email; wanted to be converted by Saturday, June 30, 2012.
 - Timing not realistic to make Saturday deadline.
