Title of Item:

Board Elections: Odd/Even Years

Background and Analysis:

At the board meeting on December 6, 2010, trustees discussed the possibility of changing the trustee election years from odd-numbered years to even-numbered years.

With the Palo Alto City Council's success in moving their elections from odd years to even years, it would cost Foothill-De Anza approximately \$50,000 to keep its trustee elections on odd-numbered years.

Included in this item is cost information from the Registrar of Voters.

- Estimated Election Cost & Explanation of Ballot Types

It should be noted that there is a one-time charge of \$20,000 to process the election year change in the Registrar of Voters' information management system. In addition, the Elections Code requires the district/ROV to send out notices to all its voters. Since Foothill-De Anza has about 200,000 households, an additional \$200,000 in one-time mailing costs (\$1.00/letter includes postage, letterhead, envelopes, mailing house services, etc.) would be incurred. The total amount to switch from odd to even election years would be about \$220,000.

The estimated costs above do not include the cost of candidate statement, which is estimated at \$5,060 each candidate

Pursuant to Elections Code section 10002, the district is required to reimburse the County in full for the elections services it has requested. The full costs of the district's share on the costs of the election will be available at least 60 days after the election. The costs reflected above, are <u>ESTIMATES ONLY</u> and may change following the final calculation of the actual costs of the election.

To change the election date from November of odd years to November of even years, the district will be charged a one-time cost of approximately \$20,000 to process the change in the election information management systems. The Elections Code requires the district/ROV to send out notices to all its voters. FHDA has about 200,000 households. An additional mailing cost of \$200,000 based on an estimate of \$1.00 per letter (postage/letterhead/envelopes/mailing house, etc.) will be charged. Therefore, the total estimated one-time charge to process the change is about \$220,000.

Also additional booklets need to be ordered for office use and to provide each polling place—with certain number of booklets for each language.

Note: In a UDEL Election, the voters of the City of Palo Alto (40,000) are also in the pool of voters for the Foothill De Anza College and the Palo Alto Unified. Therefore, the three jurisdictions would normally share in the cost of a ballot type. Should the City of Palo Alto decide to move its election to an even-numbered year, the remaining jurisdictions will have to share the election cost that normally would be borne by the City of Palo Alto. As shown in the spreadsheet above, the two remaining schools' election cost would each increase by \$50,000.

The UDEL spreadsheet is an estimate of how the election cost will be spread among all three jurisdictions in Scenario A and between only two jurisdictions in Scenario B.

Scenario A assumes that all 3 jurisdictions participate in the Nov. 2011 election. Of the 207,000 FHDA voters, 161,000 are purely FHDA voters and 46,000 are also PAUSD &/or City of PA residents. Of the 46,000 PAUSD voters, only 40,000 are City of PA voters. Different ballot types will have to be created and printed by the Registrar so that the individual voters will will only receive ballots for isues they are voting for.

Ballot Type #1 (40,000 ballots) will contain 3 issues: 1 issue each for FHDA, PAUSD & City of PA. Therefore, the cost of this ballot type will be split among all 3 participants.

Ballot Type #2 (6,000 ballots) will only have 2 issues: 1 issue each for FHDA & for PAUSD voters who are not City of PA residents. Cost will be split between 2 participants.

Ballot Type #3 (161,000 ballots) will only have 1 issue: for FHDA voters who are neither PAUSD nor City of PA voters. Cost will be to FHDA only.
