TO REQUEST AN EXTENSION DUE TO LATE INCOME TAX FILING:

Employees who delay filing income taxes must submit a copy of the **2008 Application for Automatic Extension of Time to File U.S. Individual Income Tax Return (Form 4868)** to Secova no later than **June 15, 2009** to request an extension. By this date you must advise Secova whether you will be using the extended deadline of August 15, 2009 or the full extension through October 15, 2009 (the last date to file 2008 IRS taxes). Please be advised that if you require the October 15, 2009 deadline, COBRA extension beyond August 29, 2009 is not available.

The deadline for compliance is JUNE 15, 2009.
Failure to provide the required documentation by June 15,
2009 will result in termination of dependent coverage effective
June 30, 2009.
