 - Sickle cell
 - Tobacco use
 - Type 2 diabetes
 - Vision
 - Immunizations, including:
 - Hepatitis A
 - Hepatitis B
 - Influenza
 - Measles, mumps, rubella
 - Meningococcal
 - Pneumococcal
 - Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis
 - Inactivated poliovirus
