Agenda Items:

- 1. Process for locking out INB access for inactive assignments.
 - Run student and separation report once a month.
 - Modify report to include casual employees that do not have active assignments.
 - Lock out INB access for students and casual employees with inactive assignments.
 - Run script to purge inactive assignments 12 months old or older.
 - Team members approve of process.
- 2. Faculty Leave Reporting March 2013, Spring quarter.
 - Go Live with one division January 2013 Foothill PE.
 - Go Live with another division February 2013 De Anza Business.
 - More internal testing in December.
 - More front end testing needed.
- 3. Oracle 11g Conversion.
 - Issues with upgrade and connecting to Oracle database; cannot implement until resolved.
 - Working on finding root cause to upgrade issues.
- 4. Hyperion and ARGOS
 - Hyperion is still used heavily by various departments.
 - Request more training for converting Hyperion to ARGOS reports.
- 5. IA Plus system retires June 30, 2013.
 - All data moved into Oracle or Banner by June 30, 2013.
 - Have plan to migrate historical data.
- 6. FSA Atlas.
 - Infrastructure in place; go live Spring quarter 2013.
 - Colleges currently using work around.
 - Discussions of additional recruitment and CCCApply for international students need to be looked into, International student offices were not interested in CCCApply, and have different requirements.
- 7. Early Summer Session at Foothill Foothill has decided to continue having early Summer sessions.
 - Impact on Financial Aid, Registration and Finance need to be discussed.
 - Foothill Financial Aid is asking for an exemption from the department of education waiver granted.
 - Would allow same work around used from last year.
 - Delay separating tables.
 - o Consultant will be onsite in January 2013 to help with tables.
- 8. Pay to stay decision made by Senior Staff; Students must pay or sign up for installment plan when registering.
 - Drop students from courses not paid instead of by outstanding balance (was done in IA Plus); students would not be dropped by courses already paid for.
 - Better notification of drop for nonpayment to students.
 - o Currently send 3 emails.
 - Use SARS for additional texting message option in future.
