1. Review of Degreeworks Audit:

- Chien will email report with comments to team this week.
 - Components of Degreeworks are working.
 - Degree plans are working.
 - Usage issue – CSU attributes are hard wired to courses; will have to be modified every time courses change.

2. Waitlist/Add Codes:

- Students have to drop themselves from waitlist to use add codes.
 - Some classes have custom messages, stops add code screen from popping up.
 - Work around – turn off custom messages.
 - SGHE defect – open ticket with SGHE.

3. 8.4 Patch is in PRODN (CalB8.4, Student 8.4.1, SSB):

- Ready for testing.
- Will fit in additional steps recommended by SGHE for CalB if needed.
- In production by May 31, 2011

4. BDMS Update:

- Have conversion script and instructions from SGHE.
- Pat Fifield has verified converted data.
- Ready to do test first pass conversion.
- Matt has written a script to replace social security numbers with CWIDs.
 - Will reject anything with 10 digits and place in separate Legacy cabinet.
 - Will need audit trail.

5. Transcripts:

- Do not print correctly with FormFusion.
- Another option for printing is Open Source software from Apache foundation.
 - Will not change A & R process and is supported by the printers in A & R offices.
 - Transfer courses do not need to be listed; only institution name and number of units is needed.
 - Matt will work with A & R offices to finalize.

6. Log in/timeout Issue – reported by Shawna:

- Working in INB, go to Student Dashboard (SSB) and is asked to log in, but cannot log in because already logged in.
 - Single sign on issue; can turn on re-login option every time logging into SSB.
 - Matt will look into solution.

7. Security Report:

- Locked accounts have are not part of report because ARGOS does not have access to the table locked accounts are in.
 - Will ask for ARGOS to be granted view access to table for report.
 - Demo report next week for team leads to review.
8. Course Studio – RA Status Issue:
- Students with RA status (re-add) cannot be part of member list; Course Studio does not recognize as a registered student.
 - Work around in place (faculty can add students as guests) – Drake sent target announcement to faculty April 7, 2011.
 - RA has been added in user parameter and Banner now recognizes RA students as registered students.
 - RS is another code in Course Studio table that FHDA does not use. Joe will ask SGHE if it is needed for Course Studio.
9. Grade Roll:
- De Anza Winter grade roll – April 16, 2011.
 - Foothill Winter grade roll – April 17, 2011.
10. Touchnet Payment Gateway Advisory:
- Touchnet will be down from Midnight to 4am tonight for maintenance.
 - A & R offices will send out a target announcement to students.
 - Rachel will send out for De Anza.
 - Shawna will send out for Foothill.
 - Touchnet outage may affect settlement reports.

Outstanding Student Issues:

1. Add Codes/Drop for Nonpayment:
 - Steering Committee recommends removing students from roster when dropped for nonpayment so add codes will work.
 - Test script to remove students tomorrow; will be ready for Spring quarter.
 - Will run script the week before classes start.
2. Security Fine Grain Access Report:
 - Initial review is complete; working on format.
3. Roombook:
 - Delivered to both colleges; working on second phase development based on colleges' input.
4. P/NP internal Q code – fixed; monitoring.
5. Waitlist Patch – in production; monitoring.
6. Grade Roll excessive run issue:
 - Appworks will resolve.
7. 320 Report:
