DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE POSITION INCLUDE:

Under the direction of the Dean, oversee the daily operations of the HOPE Program, De Anza College. Work closely with the Vocational Instructor assigned to the HOPE program. Provide instructional support services and supervision to developmentally disabled adults in a vocational work program setting. Implement a Student Educational Contract (SEC) for each student on a designated caseload. Assign work related to goal achievement, provide feedback to students, and document all behaviors pertinent to SEC and program planning. Maintain daily student records to assess progress of students as related to their SEC. Develop, explain, and demonstrate learning exercises. Prepare instructional materials to aid in student comprehension of coursework. Instruct students about professional behavior necessary in the workplace and the community. Set up and run production jobs. Train students to meet customer standards with regard to assigned production work. Prepare progress reports and develop vocational goals and objectives. Maintain student productivity/attendance vocational records. Support instructor by gathering staffing statistics and scheduling meetings. Assist in the review of academic, medical, and vocational records to comply with federal and state mandates. Assist instructor with the quarterly registration process of De Anza students. Order, receive, catalog, and store supplies, materials and equipment. Notify family members and outside agencies of meetings and other significant events impacting students' lives. Actively participate in student meetings. Use adaptive equipment and materials to meet the unique needs of each person's disability. Maintain HOPE Program classroom environments, assuring they are safe, clean, and organized. Make minor repairs and adjustments to equipment as needed. Perform related duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Understanding of, sensitivity to, and respect for the diverse academic, socio-economic, ethnic, religious, and cultural backgrounds, disability, and sexual orientation of community college students, faculty and staff.
- Any combination equivalent to an Associate's degree.
- 3. Three years related instructional experience.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Knowledge and understanding of physical, mental, and developmental disabilities.

- Ability to inspire and engage students and their families, De Anza College/HOPE staff, and other community agencies.
