DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE POSITION INCLUDE:

Under the direction of the Dean of Applied Technologies, provide instruction in Manufacturing and CNC courses. Subjects include but are not limited to; concepts, theories and working knowledge of conventional and CNC machining operations, CNC set-up and programming, CAD/CAM programming, tool design, GD&T, and materials and processes using a variety of teaching techniques as required in lectures and laboratory activities. Teaching assignments will include evening instruction.

Standard duties expected of all faculty include development and evaluation of curricula, maintaining scheduled office hours, attending department and division meetings, pursuing professional growth activities, and performing other duties consistent with the role of an instructor. Instructors also have the opportunity to serve on District and college committees and participate in campus extra-curricular activities.

- Working knowledge of CAD/CAM platforms, precision mechanical inspection, Geometric Dimensioning & Tolerancing (GD&T) tool design, and abrasive machining.
- 4. Knowledge of materials and treatment, manufacturing processes, cutting tool geometry and thread form calculation, classes, and manufacturing.
