The Foothill-De Anza Community College District is currently accepting applications for the faculty position of **Child Development Instructor**, **Foothill College**.

#### DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE POSITION INCLUDE:

Teach a variety of college-level courses that fulfill either general education requirements or an Associate of Arts degree in Child Development. Provide classroom instruction in accordance with established course outlines.

Standard duties expected of all faculty include development and evaluation of curricula, maintaining scheduled office hours, attending department and division meetings, pursuing professional growth activities, and performing other duties consistent with the role of an instructor. Instructors also have the opportunity to serve on District and college committees and participate in campus extra-curricular activities.

#### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Understanding of, sensitivity to, and respect for the diverse academic, socio-economic, ethnic, religious, and cultural backgrounds, disability, and sexual orientation of community college students, faculty and staff.

Master's degree in child development, early childhood education, human development, home economics/family and consumer studies with a specialization in child development/early childhood education, educational psychology with a specialization in child development/early childhood education OR Bachelor's degree in any of the above AND Master's degree in social work, educational supervision, elementary education, special education, psychology, bilingual/bicultural education, life management/home economics, family life studies or family and consumer studies OR the equivalent.

### PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

 Knowledge, ability, and enthusiasm to teach any of the following lower-division courses: School Age Child; Infant/Toddler Development; Atypical Infant Development: Affirming Diversity in Education; Child Growth and Development; Observation; Child Development; Curriculum for the Preschool Classroom; Language Development; Child, Family and Community; Positive Behavior Management; Mentoring; Practicum; or Administration and Supervision.

- 2. Successful experience teaching students of ethnically and culturally diverse backgrounds at the community college level.
- 3. Interest in teaching courses online.
- Experience in coordinating and overseeing programs serving children and families.
- 5. Ability to use various teaching methods that a) engage students in their own learning, including outcomes that motivate students to develop higher-order thinking skills, and b) ensure consistent and appropriate monitoring of student progress.
- 6. Experience with professional and community-related projects and organizations related to child development.
- Willingness to seek outside funding sources, prepare funding proposals for projects and instruction, monitor budgets, and complete necessary reports.
- 8. Initiative and ability to develop courses.
- Commitment to the mission of the community college and its philosophy of education.
- Demonstrated enthusiasm and interest in working cooperatively with colleagues in multiple departments and in serving on college committees in a shared governance organization.

- 5. In a separate document provide a response of no more than two double-spaced, typed pages to the following question: What would you do as a faculty member to increase student retention, course completion, and persistence in Child Development courses at Foothill College?
- 6. Photocopies of all college transcripts.
