The Foothill-De Anza Community College District is currently accepting applications for the faculty position of **Athletic** Trainer/Instructor, Foothill College. This position requires weekend and evening work.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE POSITION INCLUDE:

Assume the primary teaching role and faculty leadership in athletic training within the Physical Education and Athletics Division. Provide for an efficient and effective first aid, emergency care, injury prevention, athletic training and conditioning programs for athletes in intercollegiate sport activities. Provide initial evaluation and emergency first aid for student athletes requiring care. Maintain health records and administer insurance program for athletes. Oversee classified athletic trainer and other training room staff: Order and maintain inventory, supplies and appropriate therapeutic modalities for injury care. Oversee the daily maintenance and care of the athletic treatment centers. Function as a liaison between physician, coaches, parents, student athletes and administration. Administer a sports medicine program for students including the recruitment and direction of student trainers. Serve as the athletic trainer for home and some away athletic contests.

Standard duties expected of all faculties include development and evaluation of curricula, maintaining scheduled office hours, attending department and division meetings, pursuing professional growth activities, and performing other duties consistent with the role of an instructor. Instructors also have the opportunity to serve on District and college committees and participate in campus extra-curricular activities.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Understanding of, sensitivity to, and respect for the diverse academic, socio-economic, ethnic, religious, and cultural backgrounds, disability, and sexual orientation of community college students, faculty and staff.
- Master's degree in physical education, exercise science, education with an emphasis in physical education, kinesiology, physiology of exercise, or adaptive physical education OR Bachelor's degree in any of the above AND Master's degree in any life science, dance, physiology, health education, recreation administration, or physical therapy OR the equivalent.
- NATA (National Athletic Trainers Association) ATC Certificate.
- 4. Valid driver's license.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Two years teaching experience.
- 2. Three years experience in athletic injury care setting.
- 3. Leadership in sports medicine program.
- 4. Certification to teach CPR and First Aid.

In addition, successful candidates will demonstrate the following:

- The ability to organize and communicate course content to a diverse group of students.
