DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE POSITION INCLUDE:

Under the direction of the Dean, Physical Science, Mathematics and Engineering, instruct community college mathematics courses to a diverse student population with diverse learning styles. Courses range from pre-algebra and algebra to statistics, calculus, discrete mathematics, linear algebra and differential equations. Revise and develop curriculum as it relates to the discipline, infusing multicultural perspectives and contributions where appropriate.

Standard duties expected of all faculty include development and evaluation of curricula, maintaining scheduled office hours, attending department and division meetings, pursuing professional growth activities, and performing other duties consistent with the role of an instructor. Instructors also have the opportunity to serve on District and college committees and participate in campus extra-curricular activities.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Understanding of, sensitivity to, and respect for the diverse academic, socio-economic, ethnic, religious, and cultural backgrounds, disability, and sexual orientation of community college students, faculty and staff.
- Master's degree in mathematics or applied mathematics OR Bachelor's degree in either of the above AND Master's degree in statistics, physics, or mathematics education OR the equivalent.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Recent experience teaching lower division courses in mathematics or statistics.
- Experience motivating and teaching students with diverse cultural, socio-economic and ethnic backgrounds, preparation, learning styles, and disabilities.
- Awareness of the historical and cultural development of mathematics and the contributions of diverse cultures to that development.
- 4. Recent professional development activities or coursework related to teaching mathematics.
- Ability to use instructional methods that emphasize cooperation and collaboration.
- Experience in applying mathematics in a non-teaching environment.

In addition, successful candidates will demonstrate the following:

- 1. Ability to demonstrate a willingness to teach the full range of courses offered.
- Ability to work collaboratively with colleagues in the department and division.
- 3. Ability to demonstrate a willingness to incorporate technology in the teaching and learning process.
- 4. Ability to and interest in using a variety of instructional modes.
- 5. Ability to convey a sense of enthusiasm and excitement about mathematics.
- Ability to design and teach courses that engage students in their own learning and motivate students to develop critical thinking skills.

 - a) Why do you want to teach mathematics at a community college?
 - b) What makes you an effective teacher?

Questions should be answered using the following format:

- Use a separate document for each question
- Provide a header restating each question
- Must be type written or written legibly
- Length of answer may not exceed more than one side of one page

Incomplete application packets will not be forwarded to the search committee for review.
