The Foothill-De Anza Community College District is currently accepting applications for the faculty position of Women's Soccer Coach, Physical Education and Human Performance, Foothill College. The position is 50% coaching and 50% teaching. Teaching assignments may include week-end and/or evening classes.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE POSITION INCLUDE: Under the direction of the Dean, Physical Education and Human Performance, coach women's soccer. Teach a variety of physical education classes, which may include aquatics, golf, dance, yoga, swimming, tennis, spinning, Pilates, and aerobics. Organize and oversee assistant coaches and staff for practices, games, recruitment, and accounting. Stay current on all conference and Commission on

Athletics rules and guidelines. Assist student athletes with transfer to four year institutions. Work closely with soccer coaches from the college's feeder schools to develop rapport, enhance recruitment of student athletes, and facilitate the continuity of college admission. Maintain active involvement with student activities, sports promotion, and athletic department fundraising events.

Standard duties expected of all faculty include development and evaluation of curricula, maintaining scheduled office hours, attending department and division meetings, pursuing professional growth activities, and performing other duties consistent with the role of an instructor. Instructors also have the opportunity to serve on District and college committees and participate in campus extra-curricular activities.

#### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Understanding of, sensitivity to, and respect for the diverse academic, socio-economic, ethnic, religious, and cultural backgrounds, disability, and sexual orientation of community college students, faculty and staff.
- Master's degree in physical education, exercise science, education with an emphasis in physical education, kinesiology, physiology of exercise, or adaptive physical education OR Bachelor's degree in any of the above AND Master's degree in any life science, dance, physiology, health education, recreation administration, or physical therapy OR the equivalent.

## PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Teaching experience in a variety of physical education courses.
- 2. Two years coaching experience in soccer at the high school, college or professional level.
- 3. Technical knowledge of all aspects of coaching soccer.

In addition, successful candidates will demonstrate the following:

- 1. Ability to work with students of diverse skill levels and socioeconomic, cultural, and ethnic backgrounds.
- 2. Ability to communicate effectively with students and colleagues.
- 3. Ability to provide leadership in athletics.
- 4. Ability to teach a variety of physical education courses.
