DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE POSITION INCLUDE:

Under the direction of the Dean, Counseling and Matriculation Division, provide general counseling services to our international student population. Provide academic, personal, and career counseling services. Develop and implement orientation, registration, and counseling related activities and workshops. Assist students in clarifying academic goals, selecting a major, and planning for transfer, associate degrees, or certificate programs. Instruct and counsel students regarding college success, human development and career/life planning. Provide detailed counseling related to resolution of complex issues pertaining to immigration law. Participate in recruitment and outreach activities for international students. Serve as a liaison with instructional divisions.

Standard duties expected of all counselors include development and evaluation of curricula, maintaining scheduled office hours, attending department and division meetings, pursuing professional growth activities, and performing other duties consistent with the role of an instructor. Instructors also have the opportunity to serve on District and college committees and participate in campus extra-curricular activities.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Understanding of, sensitivity to, and respect for the diverse academic, socio-economic, ethnic, religious, and cultural backgrounds, disability, and sexual orientation of community college students, faculty and staff.
- Master's degree in counseling, rehabilitation counseling, clinical psychology, counseling psychology, guidance counseling, educational counseling, social work or career development, OR the equivalent.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Knowledge and experience pertaining to SEVIS/Department of Homeland Security non-immigrant F-1 rules and regulations.
- 2. Two years counseling/teaching experience in a community college.
- 3. Experience in developing curriculum, and facilitating workshops to enhance the international students' educational experiences.
- 4. Experience in establishing and maintaining linkages with on and off campus programs and services.
- 5. Proficiency in another language other than English.

 Experience counseling or advising students of various nationalities.

In addition, successful candidates will demonstrate the following:

- 1. Knowledge and experience in serving the needs of the international student population.
- Ability to design and implement retention services for the international student population.
- Knowledge of and experience in intercultural communication skills and resources.
- Ability to communicate effectively with non-native English speakers.
- Ability to provide personal, educational, and career counseling to international students.
