Education: Master's degree in physical education, education with an emphasis in physical education, kinesiology, physiology of exercise, or adaptive physical education **OR** Bachelor's degree in any of the above **AND** Master's degree in any life science, dance, physiology, health education, recreation administration, or physical therapy **OR** the equivalent.

Ability: Understanding of, sensitivity to, and respect for the diverse academic, socio-economic, ethnic, cultural, disability, religious background and sexual orientation of community college students, faculty and staff.
