DESCRIPTION:

Coach intercollegiate Men's water polo. Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Provide the organization, direction, and administration of the Men's Water Polo program.
- Perform coaching duties at practices and contests.
- Preparation and management for home meets.
- Recruit student-athletes from the college's recruiting areas.
- Schedule contests, arrange transportation, and manage the budget.
- Stay current on all Division, District, Conference and Commission on Athletics rules and policies.
- Develop an off- season conditioning and strength program that monitors the progress of the student-athletes.
- Assist with all De Anza College Physical Education and Athletic Division fundraising events.
- Work effectively with the athletic trainers, academic advisor, equipment manager(s) and others in the Department.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Education: Bachelor's degree **AND** two years of experience **OR** an Associate's degree **AND** six years of experience. *Certification for Safety Training for Swim and/or Lifeguard required for all water sports.*

Preferred: Master's in physical education, exercise science, education with an emphasis in physical education, kinesiology, physiology of exercise, or adaptive physical education **OR** Bachelor's in any of the above **AND** Master's in any life science, dance, physiology, health education, recreation administration, or physical therapy **OR** the equivalent.

Ability: Understanding of, sensitivity to, and respect for the diverse academic, socio-economic, ethnic, religious, and cultural backgrounds, disability, and sexual orientation of community college students, faculty and staff.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

To be considered for this pool, you must submit the following:

1. A completed application form located at www.fhdajobs.net
(The only form of application accepted)
2. A current resume that details your education and complete work history
3. A cover letter
4. A separate document that provides information which demonstrates your understanding of, sensitivity to, and respect for the diverse academic, socio-economic, ethnic, religious, and cultural backgrounds, disability, and sexual orientation of community college students, faculty and staff
5. Copies of **all** college transcripts

Please note: If you are unable to attach your transcripts electronically, please have them available when interviewed.

Do not: Submit application, resume, cover letter, diversity statement or transcripts in paper form—they will not be accepted.

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

Foothill-De Anza Community College District is establishing a pool of qualified applicants for Men's Water Polo Coach. Applications will be accepted continuously until otherwise noted. Applications will remain on file for two years from date received.

SELECTION PROCEDURE:

Applications will be screened by appropriate department representatives on an as-needed basis. Qualified applicants who best meet the needs of the division will be contacted for an interview.
