We introduce a new student ID card and printing technology associated with it starting this fall quarter.

With this new technology, you can upload or send by email your print jobs and assignments to your web account. Then you can go to any of the printer locations on campus, use your new ID card, swipe it and get your print outputs.

Both colleges will hold new carding events during the first week of school. You can sign up, get your photo taken and receive your new student ID card. Both colleges will hold this carding event at their respective campus centers. Make sure you take time to visit their booth, and get your new student ID card.
