On December 7, Linda Thor sent an e-mail message with great news for classified staff. It is worth repeating for those of you who may not have seen the original:

Dear colleagues,

I have some great news I'd like to share with you.

At last night's meeting, the Board of Trustees announced that it supports my recommendation to fold both the Escrow II and Deferment I positions into the adopted budget for 2010-11. These were the positions that had been scheduled for elimination at the end of June 2011. As a result of this decision, both these layoff lists have been abolished.

I can't think of a happier holiday message to be sending you today.

Thank you to the bargaining units and Human Resources for working so diligently in pursuing this action.

As noted in my fiscal outlook message to you Friday, we still face some budget challenges. Should the need arise for further reductions as a result of state action, the district will work together with the bargaining units to resolve any issues that may arise.

I know that restoring these positions to the budget will only enhance what I hope will be a wonderful holiday for all of you. Thanks to each of you for all you do.
